There is no formal arrangement made for the workshop with hotels due to circumstances related to covid-19. Delegates must make all arrangements with these hotels directly. Hotels suggested below have a good connection to the NFI by public transport and are located in the city centre of The Hague.

Other Hotels:

Other hotels are available in the area. Connection to the NFI by public transport may be less convenient from this hotels. The social events or the drop-off after such an event are located in the city centre of The Hague.

Amsterdam Schiphol AIRPORT:

Amsterdam Schiphol Airport is situated about 46 kilometres from The Hague City Centre. Train and taxis to The Hague city centre are available at the airport. A taxi will drop you to the door of your hotel. The cost is approximately €62 (approx. 35 minutes). The train brings you to The Hague city centre in ca. 30-45 minutes and costs ca. € 10 for a single travel in second class. Thereafter you can either take a taxi or a tram or bus. Some of the recommended hotels are in walking distance to train station The Hague Central Station. Note that there are two main train stations in The Hague: Central Station and HS (Holland Spoor).

PUBLIC TRANSPORT:

From Schiphol Airport to The Hague Central Station (Den Haag CS)

All recommended hotels are located near The Hague Central Station (please note that The Hague HS is not the same station). At Schiphol Airport the trains to The Hague CS leave at 07, 16, 26, 37, 46 and 56 minutes past every hour from platform 5 or 6 (watch the electronic information boards at platform 5 and 6). Travelling by train from Schiphol Airport to The Hague CS takes about 30 minutes. Tickets can be bought at the ticket machines or the NS-desk. NS is the Dutch railway company; look for the NS-logo:

From The Hague Central Station to your hotel

Directions to the NFI

The best way to reach the NFI from either your hotel in the city centre or train station is by **tram 15** in the direction of '**Nootdorp**'. Tram 15 runs every 10 minutes during the day and will take you in approximately 25 minutes to the NFI. Please note that you have to *press the 'stop'-button after you've passed 'Laan van 's-Gravenmade'*. The NFI is at the next stop: '**Laan van Ypenburg**'. With the HTM Day cards you can only use HTM busses and trams. Therefore, don't take EBS bus 30 to the NFI or back to your hotel. (otherwise you can pay in the bus for a single ticket)

For delegates it is most suitable to buy a HTM 3-Day Ticket, this is the most convenient public transport card available for tourists and visitors to The Netherlands. **With this card you will get unlimited travel over the workshop period on HTM busses and trams.**

- HTM 3 days Ticket (72 hours)

Your time period starts from the first time you use the card. For extra days you can buy a HTM Day Ticket or a HTM 2-Hour Ticket.

Note that also busses from other companies drive in the The Hague region, so be sure to pick a HTM bus or tram. HTM tickets are not valid in public transport from other companies, such as EBS.
